All Members being present, the Secretary read the Minutes of the last meeting, which were adopted as being correct by motion of Councillors McDonald and Anderson. CARRIED.

Reeve Heppner stated that the Morris Community Hospital was in need of funds and representatives of the Morris Agricultural Society met the Council with regard to a Grant to the annual fair. By motion of Councillors Thiessen and McDonald, a Grant of \$300.00 was authorized to the Morris Agricultural Society and a Grant of \$400.00 to the Morris Community Hospital. CARRIED.

Court of
Electors
Revision

At the hour of 1.00 O'Clock P.M. the Council sat as a Court of Revision to revise the Electors' Roll for the year 1947. After all known changes were made, the following motion passed:

Davidson - Ribordy:

That the changes made in the list of Electors by the Assessor be accepted and the revised list be made accordingly and 100 copies of same be printed. That as no appeals were lodged, the Court of Revision do now close and the list as revised be the list of Electors for the year 1947. CARRIED.

Culvert to
Sperling

Councillor Ribordy stated that it would be necessary to purchase a culvert for the Village of Sperling and that the United Church at Sperling would pay half the cost of same and the following motion passed:

Ribordy - Thiessen:

That the Municipality order one x 100 ft. culvert for the United Church at Sperling, the United Church to pay half the cost of same and culvert to be shipped to Sperling. CARRIED.

That By-Law No. 725, being a By-Law for the purpose of changing the boundary of Willow Heights and Green Bank School Districts, having been read a first time, be now considered as having been read the second and third times and passed and the Reeve and Clerk be hereby authorized to sign and seal same. CARRIED.

Bridge plank

Reeve Heppner reported that he thought we should purchase some bridge plank if available and the following motion passed:

Ribordy - Davidson:

That D. Heppner, Drainage Trustee, be authorized to order two cars of bridge plank from the Drainage Maintenance Board. CARRIED.

Bills and accounts were handed to the Finance Committee, who reported that the Treasurer be authorized to pay same as per list.

Stevenson - Davidson:

That the accounts amounting to the sum of \$55,894.30 approved by the Finance Committee be passed and the Reeve and Clerk be hereby authorized to issue cheques for the several amounts. CARRIED.

Reeve Heppner read a letter issued to C.N.R. Foremen with regard to Caterpillar Tractors lifting rails at crossings.



