Applications.

Applications of ANNA A. MULDER and KATHERINA FUNK for Old Age Pension were presented to the Council for consideration and the following motion was passed:
Anderson - Thiessen:-

That the applications of Anna A. Mulder and Katherina Funk be recommended to the Old Age Pension Board for acceptance. CARRIED.

McDonald - Davidson:-

That By-Law No. 728, being a By-Law re: The Morris Hospital District No. 25, having been read the first and second times on October 3rd, be now considered as having been read the 3rd time and passed, and the Reeve and Clerk be hereby authorized to sign and seal same. CARRIED.

Culverts &
snow-fence.

Councillors Anderson, Stevenson, and Thiessen, advised of their respective requirements of culverts and snow-fence in their wards and the following motions authorizing the purchase of same were carried:-

Anderson - Ribordy:-

That Councillor Stevenson purchase one 18"x 26' culvert, one 18"x 24' culvert, and one 18"x 22' culvert, also 5 rolls of snow-fence. CARRIED.

Ribordy-Davidson:-

That Councillor Anderson purchase 200' of snow-fence and Councillor Thiessen purchase 200' of snow-fence. CARRIED.

A letter from Mr. Cameron of the Highways Branch of the Department of Public Works, advising that the unexpended Grant on the Morris - St. Elizabeth road would be carried over until 1948, was read.

A letter from Mr. R.A. Wilson of the Dept. of Agriculture, asking the Council to withdraw Townships 4-1E, 5-2W, 6-1W, & 6-2W, from the application made for Prairie Farm Assistance to the farmers of this Municipality, was read, and the following motion passed re same:-

Davidson-Ribordy:-

That Townships 4-1E., 5-2W., 6-1W., 6-2W., be withdrawn from the application made for Prairie Farm Assistance for the farmers of this Municipality. CARRIED.

Accounts.

Bills and accounts were handed to the Finance Committee, who reported that the Treasurer be authorized to pay same as per list.

Anderson - Thiessen:-

That the accounts amounting to the sum of \$32,325.30, approved by the Finance Committee be passed, and the Reeve and Treasurer be authorized to issue cheques for the several amounts. CARRIED.



The meeting then adjourned, next meeting to be held in the Court House Building at Morris on December, 19th, next.
