The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris met for the regular monthly meeting on the above date at the Court House Building in the Town of Morris. All members being present, the Secretary read the minutes of the last meeting, which were adopted as being correct by motion of Councillors Anderson and Stevenson.

CARRIED.

D. Heppner to try and purchase Right-of-way on S.E.34-4-1W.

Anderson - Neufeld;

That this Council give D. Heppner, Drainage Trustee, the right to try and purchase a right-of-way across the S.E.34-4-1W., as an outlet for the Cobb and St. Peters drains.

CARRIED.

Grant of \$400.00 to Morris Comm. Hospital.

Stevenson - Davidson;

That the Municipality of Morris give a grant of \$400.00 to the Morris Community Hospital and hereby approve of the former grants given to the said hospital during 1948.

CARRIED.

Tenders to be asked for for the painting of Red River Bridge.

As word from the Department of Public Works did not reach us in time to advertize for tenders for the scraping, brushing and painting the Red River Bridge at Morris in time to advertize earlier, it was decided now to advertize same as information was received from the Department by letter dated June 21st, 1948.

Collette - Anderson;

That we advertize in the Free Press, Tribune and Morris Herald, asking for tenders for the scraping, brushing and painting two coats of illuminum paint on the Red River Bridge at Morris. Municipality to supply the paint. Tenders to be in by 12.00 O'Clock noon, August 10th, 1948 and that we employ Mr. R.J. Murray of the Department to supervise the work. Lowest or any tender not necessarily accepted.

CARRIED.

Court of Electors' Roll Revision.

Mr. Thring, the Assessor attended at the meeting at the hour of two O'Clock for the purpose of attending the Court of Revision of the Electors' Roll. Mr. Bower of Union Point also attended at the Court of Revision with regard to names to be struck off and names to be added to the Roll of the Electors' of that district. At the hour of 2.00 O'Clock P.M., the Council sat as a Court of Revision to hear any complaints against the Roll for the year 1948. A letter from John Ouimet of Union-Point was read and considered in which a list of names to be added to the Roll and a list of names to be struck off the Roll was given.

Anderson - Ribordy;

That the changes made in the List of Electors' by the Assessor be accepted and the revised list be made accordingly for the year A.D. 1948. That 100 copies of same be printed, and that all appeals having been considered and determined, the Court of Revision do now close and the list as revised be the Electors' list for the year A.D. 1948.

CARRIED.

Councillors Authorized to order culverts.

Ribordy - Neufeld;

That Councillor Anderson be authorized to purchase two 15" x 18' culverts, One 24" x 8' extension and coupler, and Councillor Stevenson be authorized to purchase Two 12" x 22' culverts, and Councillor Davidson be authorized to purchase One 15" x 10' & coupler, One 18" x 8' & coupler, One 18" x 6' & 2 couplers and One 24" x 26' culverts.

CARRIED.

Approval and confirmation of purchase of blade grader.

Davidson - Stevenson;

That the purchase of a blade grader from the Richardson Road Machinery Co., for the sum of \$6,600.00 F.O.B. Morris, Man., with a down payment of \$2,600.00 on delivery and remainder November 1st, 1948, without interest be confirmed and approved. The payment of \$208.80, being freight on the machine to be deducted from the down payment.

CARRIED.

Mr. Prefontaine met the Council with regard to gravelling the St. Marys' road and was advised that as it was not budgeted for this year and as we had all the work to do that we could handle this year, it would have to wait until at least 1949.

A letter from McArthur and Evans re. a road-way on Mr. Jean Sorins' land was read and the Reeve and Councillor Stevenson reported that Mr. Sorin was prepared to leave the matter as is for a time until the Municipality could rectify the situation.

Bills and accounts were handed to the Finance Committee who reported that the Secretary should be authorized to pay same as per list.

Davidson - Neufeld;

That the accounts amounting to the sum of \$9141.24 approved by the Finance Committee be passed and the Reeve and Clerk be hereby authorized to issue cheques for the several amounts.

CARRIED.

The meeting then adjourned, next meeting to be held in the Court House Building at Morris on August 13th, 1948, commencing at 10.00 O'Clock A.M.
