Minutes.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris met for the regular meeting on the above date in the Court House at Morris. The Reeve declaring the meeting open the Secretary read the minutes of the last meeting, which were adopted as being correct by motion of Councillors Stevenson and Neufeld. CARRIED.

BY-LAW 761

By-Law 761 was read a first time.  
Stevenson-MacKenzie;

That By-Law 761 being a By-Law for the purpose of giving the Winnipeg Pipe Line Company the right of running an oil line across the Municipality road and lanes, having been read a first time be now considered as having been read a second and third times and passed and the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to sign and seal same. CARRIED.

That Reeve Thiessens and Councillor Neufeld be a Committee of two to look over bridges with the drainage trustee Mr. Heppner. CARRIED.

That the Clerk be requested to call a meeting of the Reeves and Councillors of Montcalm, Franklin, DeSalaberry, Ritchot and MacDonald, Thursday June 13th at 2pm. daylight time at St. Regis Hotel for the purpose of having a rural member appointed to the Rehabilitation Committee. CARRIED.

Accounts.

Neufeld-Davidson;

That the accounts amounting to \$ 4108.33 approved by the Finance Committee be passed and the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to issue cheques for the several amounts. CARRIED.


Delegations.

Mr. E. Willis Provincial Minister of Public Works and Mr. R. J. MacKenzie, District Engineer, attended at the meeting and discussed flood damage and road problems with the Council. They advised that their Department were ready to do a great deal of reconditioning the roads and would help in every way to have the roads put back in shape for traffic.

Mr. Eliason of Saskatchewan Farmers Union also attended at the meeting and advised that their association wished to contribute to the Manitoba Flood Relief Fund and that their association wanted to be sure that the Rural area or the farmers would get a fair share of this fund.

The meeting adjourned about 5pm., next meeting to be held in the Court House at Morris on July 14th, commencing at 10.00 O'Clock A.M.
