Reeve Thiessen calling the meeting to order, the Secretary read the minutes of the last meeting, which were adopted as being correct by motion of Councillors Neufeld and Collette. Carried.

That this Municipality accept the offer of the Vulcan Machinery & Equipment Co., being \$8,000.00 cash and our Austin Western maintainer complete, for three (3) Allis-Chalmers Model "D" Motor Graders complete with cabs and 7.50 by 20 all round tires and 12 ft. blades. Carried.

A letter from the Highways Branch of the Dept. of Public Works was read, in which they advised that a 100% grant of 1,800.00 was authorized for construction of Dykes on the Shannon Creek Floodway thru Sections 31 and 32 -4-1E.


A letter from the Town of Morris was read, in which they asked that this Municipality pay \$10.00 per month toward the rent of the Mounted Police House here, as they deemed the protection afforded the Rural Municipality was greater than that afforded the Town. It was decided that we would not agree to pay the \$10.00 per month as suggested.
