That Reeve Thiessen be authorized to purchase a power pump for pumping water from ditches. CARRIED.

Ribordy - Davidson; That the old Ford scraper be sold to Arthur Edel for the sum of \$25.00. CARRIED.

Bills and Accounts were handed to the Finance Committee, who reported that the Treasurer should be authorized to pay same as per list.

Neufeld - Davidson;

That the accounts amounting to the sum of \$10,212.03 approved by the Finance Committee be passed, and the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer be hereby authorized to issue cheques for the several amounts. CARRIED.

Davidson - Ribordy;

That this Council request the Government to locate or replace survey mounds around Sections 16,17,18,19,20,29,30 and 31 in Township 4 range 1E. and Section 20 in Township 6 Range 2W.

L.Stevenson = M.J.Stevenson;
That this Council request the C.N.R. to build up their crossings in the flooded area within the Rural Municipality of Morris. CARRIED.

M.J.Stevenson - Ribordy;

That this Municipality purchase a Ford Tractor CARRIED. from the Sperling Garage for the sum of \$700.00.

A letter was read from the Union of Manitoba Municipalities, advising that the Annual Meeting of the Eastern Judicial District of the Union would be held in St.Pierre on June 14th,1951.

A letter from the Highways Branch of the Dept.of Public Works was read in which they advised that the following grants on a 50/50 basis were authorized:-Grading River Road Aubigny North-\$ 1,500.00 Gravelling Morris-Dufrost Road, Intermun. with Montcalm-150.00 Grading N.15,16,17 thru.17,7-4-1E.-1,500.00

Grading Rosenfeld - Lowe Farm Road-

A letter from Mr.A. Atkin of Union Point was read, in which he asked that the Municipality re-imburse him for oars he bought last year for the boat at Union-Point.It was agreed to pay him \$4.00 for same as per his account submitted.

A letter from the Morris Branch of the Canadian Legion was read, in which they asked that this Municipality purchase a wreath for decoration day to be held June 17th. It was agreed that we purchase a wreath as requested and Councillor Neufeld agreed to place it at the Cenetaph during the Service.

Mr.Jean Sorin attended at the meeting and ssked that a culvert be placed in the ditch by his property along St.Marys' road. He was advised that the situation as to culverts at that point would be looked over.

Mr.T.C.Sanderson of Portage La Prairie attended at the meeting and advised the Council that he had two large road equipment outfits and would be pleased to do any work available for the Municipality, at the Government rates of pay.

Messrs. Braun and Giesbrecht attended at the meeting seeking advise and instructions as to their work as grasshopper supervisors.

The meeting then adjourned, next meeting to be held in the Court House at Morris on Friday, July 13th, commencing at 10.00 O'Clock in the forenoon.
