

Morris, Manitoba,
July 13th, 1951.

Minutes. The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris met in the Court House in the Town of Morris on the above date for the purpose of holding the regular monthly meeting. The Reeve calling the meeting to order, the Secretary read the Minutes of the last meeting, which were adopted as being correct, by motion of Councillors L. Stevenson and Saurette. CARRIED.

P.M. Friesen to get \$65.00 per Month. All members of the Council attended at the meeting. A letter from P.M. Friesen of Lowe Farm was read, in which he asked that his monthly aid allowance be raised to \$ 65.00 per month. Neufeld - M.J. Stevenson; That the aid allowance to P.M. Friesen be raised from \$50.00 per Month to \$65.00 per Month and that a lien be filed against his property for same. CARRIED.

Court of Revision re. Electors Roll. At 2.00 O'Clock in the afternoon, the Council set as a Court of Revision to revise the list of Electors for the year 1951. Mr. C.L. Thring attended at the meeting for this purpose. M.J. Stevenson - Saurette; That the lists of names to be added and to be taken off the Electors Roll for the year 1951 as presented by the Assessor, be approved and the necessary changes made in the Roll, and that the Court of Revision be now closed. CARRIED.

Delegations and Petitions. A delegation of four and headed by W.H. Funk, attended at the meeting with regard to wanting a road built on the telephone line road allowance, between the No. 23 highway and the southern boundary of the Municipality. They also presented a petition to that effect. Realizing that the Council had been making arrangements for a road connecting the No. 23 highway with the Southern Boundary of the Municipality, the delegation expressed their gratitude. A petition asking that a bridge be built between Sections 13 and 24 in Twp. 6, Range 1W., was read. It was decided that Councillor M.J. Stevenson and Mr. Heppner would investigate the situation.

Bills & Accts. Bills and accounts were handed to the Finance Committee, who reported that the Treasurer should be authorized to pay same as per list. Davidson - Ribordy; That the accounts amounting to the sum of \$19,085.17, approved by the Finance Committee be passed, and the Reeve and Treasurer be hereby authorized to issue cheques for the several amounts. CARRIED.

Correspondence. A letter from the Manitoba Power Commission was read, in which they advised that our dragline had caused damage to one of the Power lines and asked that we advise our operators to be more careful while working by Hydro Lines. A letter from the Dept. of Public Works was read, in which they advised that they would resurvey the East boundaries of Secs. 18, 19, 30 and 31 in Twp. 4, and Range 1 East. A letter from the Secretary of the Court House Committee was read, in which he advised \$1,534.05 was ~~needed~~ necessary to be paid by the Municipalities beside that coming from the Government for repair of the Court House, that our share of the extra would be 75% or \$1,150.54. A letter from Mrs. S. Thiessen was read, in which she asked that the Municipality allow 60¢ per day for milk for her family. Councillor Davidson advised that he would make necessary arrangements in this regard. Neufeld - Saurette; That if the harvest should be in full swing at the next regular meeting date, the Reeve may cancel same and hold a meeting on a more convenient date at his call. CARRIED. The meeting then adjourned, next meeting to be held as above stated.
