

Morris, Manitoba
June 12, 1953

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris met in the Court House Building in the Town of Morris on the above date for the purpose of holding the regular monthly meeting. Reeve MacKenzie declared the meeting opened. The Secretary read the minutes of the last meeting, which were adopted as being correct, by motion of Otto Bunkowsky and Leslie Stevenson.

All members of the Council attended at the meeting.

- Gravelling Road 2 miles South of Rosenort
Stevenson-Bunkowsky: That we gravel the road 2 miles South of Rosenort to Church with 350 yards of gravel per mile. Ward 2 and Ward 3 to share half the cost of gravelling out of their Ward appropriations. Before work commences, petitioners must pay full amount of monies as per petition presented by P.J. Loewen, dated on June 12th. Balance of monies to be held in trust by Municipality, to be used on said road at a future date. Carried.
- Office Rent 1953
Neufeld-Saurette: That we pay the Court House Committee the sum of \$480.00 for office rent for the year 1953. Carried.
- Legion Wreath
Bunkowsky-Recksiedler: That we buy a wreath for the Decoration Day Services to be held on June 14th by the Morris Branch of the Canadian Legion. Carried.
- Sec.-Treas Course
Recksiedler-Stevenson: That the Secretary-Treasurer be delegated to attend the Course in Municipal Administration and Public Finance to be held at the University June 15th to 19th inclusive, and his expenses re same be paid by the Municipality. Carried.
- Trailer Purchase
Neufeld-Recksiedler: That we purchase one two-wheel trailer from Henry Hildebrand, Lowe Farm, for the sum of \$50.00. Carried.
- Blind Pensions
Bunkowsky-Stevenson: That we recommend to the Blind Persons' Allowance Board, E. Loewen Winnipeg, the application of Mrs. Elizabeth Loewen, Rosenort. Carried.
- Provencher S.D. from Molloy & Armour S.D.
Neufeld-Stevenson: That we appoint Diedrich Heppner of Lowe Farm, as Arbitrator re petition of P.A. Robert et al, praying for transfer of Sections 25 & 26 in Twp. 5 Range 2 East from Molloy S.D. No. 1849 and also River Lots 402, 404, 406, 408, 410, 412, 414, and 416, from the Armour S.D. No. 159, TO Provencher S.D. No 997. Carried
- Kane St. Lights Rebate
Neufeld-Recksiedler: That we refund \$3.60 per year, for the years 1946 to 1952 inclusive, to the Rural Municipality of Roland re overpayment of Kane Street Lights as per agreement made in July 1945. Carried.
- C.P.R. re Maintenance of fences
Recksiedler-Neufeld: That the C.P.R. be relieved from maintaining right of way fence between mile 28.6 to mile 39.8 W. side of LaRiviere R.O.W. Carried
Neufeld-Bunkowsky: That the C.P.R. be relieved from maintaining right of way fences between mile 44.0 to mile 48.0 West of LaRiviere R.O.W. Carried
- Chairs for Court House Hall
Neufeld-Bunkowsky: That we carry our proportionate share of the cost of 100 chairs for the Court House Hall, providing the chairs will not leave the Court House Bldg. Carried
- Gravelling Road
Stevenson-Bunkowsky: That the Trump-Rosenhoff road, 2 miles, be gravelled with 350 yards gravel per mile and Ward 2 to share up to \$500.00 in 1953 from its Ward Trump to Rosenhoff per petition presented by C.K. Eide, dated June 12. Balance of monies to be held in trust by Municipality to be used on said road at a future date. Carried.
- School District advances
Neufeld-Saurette: That the Municipality will make no further advances on levies to School Districts. Carried
- Rosenort from Clover Plains S.D.
Stevenson-Bunkowsky: That By-Law No 790 being a By-Law for the purpose of detaching certain lands from the S.D. of Clover Plains and adding same to the S.D. of Rosenort, having been read a first time, be now considered as having been read a second and third time, and passed and the Reeve & Sec.-Treasurer are hereby authorized to sign and seal same. Carried
- Gravel Tenders let
Neufeld-Ribordy: That tenders calling for the gravelling of the following roads:
(1) St. Mary's (3000 yds); (2) Aubigny-Rosenort (2000 yds) and Seppling-Kane at (2000 yds) be let as follows: St. Mary's to C. Valcourt, St Jean @ \$2.25 a yd. (2.25)
Aubigny-Rosenort to Johnny Dueck, Morris @ \$2.50 a yd; also Sewell-Morris and Lowe Farm-Rosenfeld roads with 900 yds on each road @ \$2.50 a yd.
Seppling-Kane Road to Charles A. Main, Carman, @ \$3.35 a yd from Wood Pit. Carried
- Accounts
Saurette-Neufeld: That the accounts amounting to the sum of \$22,118.33 and approved by the Finance Committee, be passed, and the Reeve & Sec.-Treasurer be hereby authorized to issue cheques for the several amounts. Carried.
