SPECIAL MEETING

The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris met at a Special Meeting in the Court House Building in the Town of Morris, on the above date, for the purpose of striking the 1954 budget.

All members of the Council were present.

Stevenson-Neufeld: That, although this meeting was called for the purpose of striking the Budget for 1954, it is agreed to permit the handling of any other necessary business. Carried.

After considerable discussion, the Council decided that it would not be wise to increase taxes at a time when monies in our Municipality appeared to be scarce.

Stevenson-Neufeld: That the General Mill Rate for the R.M. of Morris for the year 1954 be set as follows: 9.5 mills for Uncontrollable Purposes; 4.5 mills for Drainage Purposes and 30 mills for Controllable Purposes, making a total general mill rate of 44 mills on the dollar. All special levies to be as per By-Law ⁸⁰² and/or ⁸⁰³ requisitions. Carried

Recksiedler-Ribordy:

That By-Law No. 802, being a By-Law for the purpose of submitting By-Law No. 795 to the electors re "establishing further Hospital facilities for the Carman Hospital District No. 20th" having been read a first time, be now considered as having been read a second and third time and passed. Carried.

Doug. Stevenson, our Agricultural Representative, appeared before Council suggesting compulsory control of Bang's Disease for this Municipality. Further information was to be gathered before a By-Law would be passed in this respect.

The meeting adjourned.
