

Morris, Manitoba,
March 12, 1954.

The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris met in the Court House Building on the above date for the purpose of holding its regular monthly meeting. After the Reeve declared the meeting opened, the Secretary read the minutes of the Feb. 12th meeting, which were adopted as read by motion of Stevenson and Recksiedler. The minutes of the Special Meeting held on Feb. 26th were also adopted as read by the same Councillors.

All members of Council were present at the meeting.

- Mr. Ginter's Pension -----Approved. Purchase of Fuel Resident Property Entrances. Shannon Floodway and Dyke payment. Inquiry of Mun. Bridge Grant. Klassen Hospital Account. Hiring Of Employees Pound Keepers Appointed.
- Neufeld-Recksiedler: That the Old Age Pension application of Peter D. Ginter, Lowe Farm, be approved. Carried.
- Ribordy-Bunkowsky: That we purchase our fuel oils and greases from the Imperial Oil at Morris and Lowe Farm Cons. Co-op at Lowe Farm for 1954. Carried.
- Neufeld-Recksiedler: That we supply one entrance only for resident property owners, and material only for one entrance for each separated property of land. Carried.
- Stevenson-Recksiedler: That we pay off all owners relative to the Shannon Floodway at the rate of \$15.00 per acre for floodway and \$40.00 per acre for Dyke on production of titles from Solicitor. Carried.
- Neufeld-Stevenson: That we ask the Department of Public Works for a Special Grant of one-third the cost of construction of a new municipal bridge across the Morris River at NE of Sec. 6-6-1E to be built in 1954 as per estimates attached. Carried.
- Neufeld-Bunkowsky: That the hospital account re: H. B. Klassen, Lowe Farm of \$303.50 be reduced by 10% providing this account is paid in full. Carried.
