The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date, with all members present.

Minutes	Upon motion of Stevenson and Neufeld, the minutes of the May 14th session were adopted as read.
Aid re O. Richard	Stevenson-Bunkowsky: That the aid re Mrs. O. Richard of Aubigny be set at \$25.00 per month, commencing on June 1st, until further notice. Carried
Sec.-Treas Course	Recksiedler-Saurette: That the Secretary-Treasurer be delegated to attend the Course in Municipal Administration and Public Finance, to be held at the University of Manitoba June 21st to June 25th, and his expenses re same be paid by the Municipality. Carried
Aubigny Ferry Rates	Saurette-Neufeld: That all residents and ratepayers of the Municipality of Morris be allowed free passage on the Aubigny Ferry and all non-residents to pay at the rate of: 25¢ per automobile or truck up to 1 ton, and 35¢ per truck over 1 ton, for one crossing, and 15¢ for a return crossing if made the same day. A Season's Pass to be charged at \$10.00 per year. Carried
By-Law 805 Flowery Bank to Rosenhoff S.D.	Stevenson-Recksiedler: That By-Law No. 805 being a By-Law for the purpose of detaching certain lands from the Flowery Bank S.D. #837 and adding same to the Rosenhoff S.D. #61, having been read a first time, be now considered as having been read a second time. Carried.
Amendment Child Welfare Act.	Bunkowsky-Recksiedler: That the Rural Municipality of Morris endorse the brief of the Welfare Council of Greater Winnipeg, petitioning the removal of Sec. 12, subsection 6(b) of the Child Welfare Act, which discriminates against non-British immigrants in need of Mothers' Allowance. Carried.
Accounts	Saurette-Bunkowsky: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$11,500.95 be passed and the Reeve & Sec.-Treasurer be hereby authorized to pay same. Carried.
Chest X-ray Survey	The Sanatorium Board of Manitoba notified the Council that its is planning a Chest X-ray survey of the Municipality this year. Dates will be announced later.
Kane Street Light moved	Upon suggestion of the Manitoba Power Commission, the street light situate on S.E. 36-4-3W, Kane, will be moved opposite the church.

The meeting adjourned and the next regular meeting will be held on Friday, July 9th, 1954 at 10 a.m.
