Minutes The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date, with all members present. Reeve Bruce MacKenzie declared the meeting opened. The Secretary read the minutes of the July 9th session, which were adopted as read by motion of Neufeld-Stevenson.

Richard Aid cancelled  
Apprehend Richard children Arbitrator  
Tremont Sperlins S.D's. Saurette-Neufeld: That the aid given Mrs. Orise Richard of Aubigny, be discontinued as of August 14th, 1954. Carried

Neufeld-Recksiedler: That we request the Children's Aid Society to apprehend the children of Mrs. Orise Richard, Aubigny, and take them as permanent wards. Carried

Neufeld-Recksiedler: That we appoint D.Heppner, Lowe Farm, as arbitrator re petition of C.B.McNulty et al, praying for the transfer of the following lands from Tremont S.D. #1127 and adding same to the Consolidated S.D. of Sperlins No. 1488, namely: the NW of 9-6-2WPM. Carried

Insurance Recksiedler-Saurette: That we add "Non-owned Automobile Liability" insurance to our Liability Policy No. A24946 with Osler, Hammond & Nanton, at a premium of \$16.94. Carried

Kane St.Light Stevenson-Neufeld: That due to transfer of a street light at Kane, the Rural Municipality of Roland herewith be released from any further costs in this connection, after Dec. 31, 1954. Carried

Third Reading By-Law 805 Stevenson-Recksiedler: That third and final reading be given By-Law No. 805 detaching the North West quarter of section 9, Twp. 5, Rge. 1 East from the Flowery Bank S.D. and adding same to the Rosenhoff S.D. and the Reeve and Sec.-Treas. are hereby authorized to sign and seal same. Carried

Term reduction debentures Morris Hospital Reckdiedler-Neufeld: That we approve the resolution passed by the Governing Board of the Morris Hospital District authorizing the reduction of the term of the debentures amounting to \$40,000. to be issued for building the medical nursing unit at Emerson, from 30 to 20 years. Carried

C. of R. Electors Roll The Court of Revision re the 1954 Electors' Roll was held at 2 p.m. As no complaints were lodged, the Roll was approved by motion of Neufeld-Recksiedler. The Voters' Lists are to be posted in every Post Office in the Municipality. Carried

Drainage work Recksiedler-Neufeld: That we approve of drainage reconstruction and levelling the dump North of 17 & 18-4-1E; North of 13 & 14-4-1W at an estimated cost of \$3,600.; and install one 36" x 50' culvert North of 17-4-1E at an estimated cost of \$375.; and clean soil drift North of 7 & 8-4-1E at an estimated cost of \$900. Carried

Anderson & Bell Drains Stevenson-Neufeld: That we approve of drainage construction on "Anderson Drain" North of 2,3,4,5 & 6-5-1W and North of 1,2, & 3-5-2W at an estimated cost of \$5,610.; and clean soil drift in the Bell Drain North of 11 & 12-5-2W at an estimated cost of \$1,200. Carried

Drain construction North of 15-4-1W Recksiedler-Ribordy: That we request the <sup>Dept. of Public Works</sup> ~~Drainage Maintenance Boards~~ to divert the water from the St. Peter drain North of Sec. 15-4-1W, easterly to the Jansen Drain, North of Sec's. 13 & 14-4-1W and 18 & 17-4-1E, by constructing a drain as soon as possible. - Two-thirds of the cost of this project to be paid by the Rural Municipality of Morris and one-third by the <sup>Dept. of Public Works</sup> ~~Reeve~~. - Upon completion of this drain, it be placed under the authority of the Drainage Maintenance Boards. Carried

Aid re Jac F Braun Neufeld-Ribordy: That we grant Jacob F. Braun, Lowe Farm, \$15.00 a month aid, commencing August 1st, and cheque to be made payable to Mrs. Jac.F.Braun. Carried

Accounts Bunkowsky-Neufeld: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$16,196.89 be passed and the Reeve & Sec.-Treas. are hereby authorized to pay same. Carried

The meeting adjourned and the next regular meeting will be held on Friday, September 10th, 1954 at 10 a.m.

Test Drill Gravel Recksiedler-Stevenson: That we make an agreement with Leandre Dupuis, St.Elizabeth to test drill for road gravel on Part SE 34-4-2E and in the event of gravel being found in sufficient quantity, the Municipality shall have the exclusive right to remove same for a period of 3 years at a cost of 10¢ per yard removed.
