Minutes The Council, of the Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date, with all members present. Reeve B. MacKenzie declared the meeting opened. The Secretary read the minutes of the Sept. 10th session which were adopted as read by motion of Recksiedler-Neufeld.

O.A.P. applicatns Neufeld-Bunkowsky: That the Old Age Pension applications of Mrs Helena Braun and Peter Braun, both of Lowe Farm, be approved. Carried

Drainage District East of Red River Saurette-Neufeld: That we request the Drainage Maintenance Boards, to form a Drainage District of that part of the Rural Municipality of Morris lying East of the Red River, described as follows: Sections: 1,2,3,4,5 & E $\frac{1}{2}$ SE of 6, 8,9,10,11,12,13,14 and E $\frac{1}{2}$  & E $\frac{1}{2}$ W $\frac{1}{2}$  of 15, and E $\frac{1}{2}$  & E $\frac{1}{2}$ SW of 22, all 23,24,25,26 and E $\frac{1}{2}$  of 35 and all 36 in Township 5, Range 2 EPM and Sections: 1, E $\frac{1}{2}$ E $\frac{1}{2}$  of 2, all 11,12,13 and SE of 14 in Township 6, Range 2 EPM and River Lots 338 to 528 inclusive. Carried

M.P.C. trans-mission line Recksiedler-Bunkowsky: That we grant the Manitoba Power Commission the right-of-way to cross that portion of River Lot 337 in the Parish of Ste Agathe, being 25 ft from the Southern Limit of said lot, owned by the Municipality, for the purpose of constructing a transmission line. Carried

Request Grant for Aubigny E. road Saurette-Neufeld: That due to the heavy traffic between the villages of Aubigny and St. Pierre, we feel the need is urgent to gravel the 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  miles from Aubigny East to the Municipality of DeSalaberry, and now request the Highways Branch of the Dept. of Public Works for a substantial grant in aid for same. A statement of the 1954 expenditures re this road is attached. Carried

Agreement re Gravel Pit Ribordy-Neufeld: That we enter into an agreement with the Elm River Hutterian Mutual Corporation to lease part of Sec. 34-4-2E for the purpose of opening a gravel pit and pay the corporation the price of 15¢ a yard for gravel removed. Carried

Tank installed at Kahe Neufeld-Recksiedler: That we approve of the installation of one 16,000 gallon vertical tank and 3 Marlow pumps with electric motors, as ~~proposed~~ proposed by the North Star Oil Ltd., Winnipeg. Carried

Acct's. Ribordy-Bunkowsky: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$9,798.41 be passed and the Reeve & Sec.-Treasurer are hereby authorized to pay same. Carried

Delegation Hon. E. Prefontaine and a delegation from DeSalaberry Mpty. attended in connection with gravelling the Aubigny-St.Pierre road.

The meeting adjourned and the next regular meeting will be held on Friday, November 12th, 1954 at 10 a.m.
