By-Law 811 Passed.

H. B. Giesbrecht-W. F. Recksiedler: That By-Law No. 811 for the purpose of erecting a school by the Lowe Farm S. D. having received the majority vote and having received first and second readings, be now read a third time and passed.

By-Law 810 Passed. (Nursing Unit at St. Claude)

Otto Bunkowsky-Ed. Saurette: That By-Law No. 810, being a By-Law for the purpose of establishing a Medical Nursing Unit at St. Claude, in the Carman Hospital District, having received the majority vote, and having been read a first and second time, be now read a third time and passed.

1955 Electors Roll Adopted.

W. F. Recksiedler-Otto Bunkowsky: The Voters' List having been advertised for 30 days and only one complaint having been lodged, be it now resolved, that the 1955 Electors' Roll, with the necessary correction, be adopted and the Court of Revision re same adjourn.

New Power Line Approved.

Wm. Schellenberg-Ed. Saurette: That we approve the establishing of a new 115,000 Volt line proposed by the Manitoba Power Commission and shown on their plans No's. 12, 13 and 14, passing through Townships 6, 5 and 4, Range 1 West.

H. B. Giesbrecht-Ed. Saurette: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$20,206.32 be passed and the Reeve & Secretary-Treasurer are hereby authorized to pay same.
