A Special Meeting was held at the Masonic Hall, Sperling, on the above date, at the request of Councillor M. Ribordy, for the purpose of discussing the feasibility of hiring a foreman to supervise work done by municipal machinery.

Approximately 15 ratepayers of the Sperling area attended. The Council of the municipality was represented by: M. Ribordy, O. Bunkowsky, W. Recksiedler and E. Saurette. Harold Fewster was nominated chairman of the meeting.

The feeling of the ratepayers at this meeting was that not enough work was being done with the amount of municipal equipment available. A foreman would be in constant touch with all outfits and thus be able to allocate the equipment to the various wards in a more equitable manner. A closer check on operators time would also result.

After considerable discussion on this subject, the following resolution was passed:

"Bill Peckover-C.H. Brown: That this meeting suggest to the Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris, that it discuss the feasibility of hiring a foreman to oversee the care maintenance and allocating of municipal machinery and that the Council contact other municipalities where foremen already are employed and ascertain there reactions as to the advisability of hiring a foreman.

The findings of this survey to be brought before the ratepayers at the annual meeting this fall."

Carried.
