D.Stevenson, Ag. Rep. attended and discussed the tree planting program for the Municipality. It was estimated that 17 miles of trees would be planted this year. Municipal Tree Planter will plant about 6 to 7 miles a day providing conditions are favorable. Tentative rates for Planter with Tractor and one man were set @ \$2.50 and hour or (part thereof) when planting in the Municipality and @ \$3.50 an hour outside the municipality. Farmer wishing to have trees planted must supply 2 men for planter.
