

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

June 8, 1956.

The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present except Ward 2 Councillor. The meeting was opened by the Reeve after which the minutes of the May 11th session and special meeting of June 1st were read and adopted by motion of Otto Bunkowsky and Ed. Saurette.

- Legion Wreath Otto Bunkowsky-Wm. Recksiedler: That we purchase a wreath for the Decoration Day Services to be held on Sunday, June 17th, on behalf of the Morris Branch of the Canadian Legion.
Carried.
- M.T.S Purchase property in Sperling Ribordy-Giesbrecht: That By-Law No. 829 being a By-Law for the purpose of selling Part of the South West quarter of Section 29-6-2W as described in CT #23845, to the Manitoba Telephone System, for the price of \$200.00, having been read a first time, be now considered as having been read a second and third time and passed, and the Reeve & Sec.-Treas. are hereby authorized to sign and seal same.

- Aid Re P. Funk H. B. Giesbrecht-Ribordy: That we pay Peter B. Funk of Lowe Farm \$20.00 a month aid commencing June 1, 1956.

- 36 inch Culverts to Bridge Account. Ribordy-H. B. Giesbrecht: That, wherever, culverts of 36 inch diameter must be used, same be charged to the "Bridges" appropriation, if installation of same is approved by Council.

- Sec.Treas Course. Recksiedler-Otto Bunkowsky: That the Secretary & Assistant Secretary be delegated to attend the Course in Municipal Administration to be held June 11th to 15th and expenses re same be paid by the Municipality. The office to remain closed during this time.

- Gravel Haul rates. W. Recksiedler-Ribordy: That truckers hauling gravel on municipal roads be paid at 8¢ per yard per mile.
Carried.
- Rates for Mowing Weeds. Otto Bunkowsky-Ed. Saurette: That the following rates be set for mowing weeds in 1956:
Ford & Mower and Man @ \$4.00 per hour.

- Arbitrator Dissolving Tremont S.D. Ribordy-Giesbrecht: That we appoint Bruce MacKenzie of Morris as arbitrator re petition of John Penner, et al requesting the dissolution of Tremont School District #1127 and transferring Sections 27, 28, 29 & 30 in Twp. 5, Rge. 2 West to Kane Consolidated S.D. #2006 and the balance of lands now in the Tremont S.D. to Sperling Consolidated S.D. #1488.
Carried.
- Arbitrator Myrtle to Kane Giesbrecht-Ribordy: That we appoint Ed. Groening, Lowe Farm as arbitrator re the petition of Jacob Schellenberg et al requesting the transfer of NE, NW and SE 13-5-3W from the Myrtle S.D. #708 and adding same to the School District of Kane #2006.
Carried.
- Accounts. Ribordy-H. B. Giesbrecht: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$17011.16 be passed and the Reeve & Sec.-Treasurer are hereby authorized to pay same.
Carried.
