September 14, 1956.

The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. The meeting was opened by the Reeve after which the minutes of the August 10th session were read and adopted by motion of Otto Bunkowsky and H. B. Giesbrecht.

Additional lights for Kane H. B. Giesbrecht-Ed. Saurette: That we request the Manitoba Power Commission to install two 150 Watt Street Lights in the village of Kane, extending East along P.T.M. #23 and change the existing 4 lights to 150 Watts. Carried.

By-Law 831 Passed. (Street Light at Sewell) Wm. Recksiedler-Wm. Schellenberg: That By-Law No. 831 approving a 5 year contract with the Manitoba Power Commission for the purpose of supplying electrical power for a street light at the Community Rink, Sewell, having been read a first time, be now considered as having been read a second and third time and passed and the Reeve and Sec.-Treas. are hereby authorized to sign and seal same. Carried.

Assistance Application Approved. H. B. Giesbrecht-Otto Bunkowsky: That the application for Old Age assistance of Peter P. Heinrichs, Lowe Farm be approved. Carried.

Accounts Wm. Recksiedler-H. B. Giesbrecht: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$24430.86 be passed and the Reeve and Sec.-Treasurer are hereby authorized to pay same. Carried.

Court of Revision. The Court of Revision for Real Property and Business Assessment will be held on October 12th at 10 A.M.

Ferguson Mower W. Recksiedler-W.Schellenberg: That we purchase one Ferguson Mower for the price of \$557.15 less trade in allowance of \$150., from B.G.Funk, Lowe Farm. Carried.

Oil Furnace Shed W. Recksiedler-W.Schellenberg: That we purchase one used oil furnace and blower from P. Martens, Lowe Far, Man. for the price of \$400.00. Carried
