Enumerators Appointed. Otto Bunkowsky-Ed. Saurette: That each Councillor be appointed enumerator in his Ward to make up the list of Electors for the year 1957. Carried.

Altona Hospital Member. M. Ribordy-Wm. Schellenberg: That we appoint B. W. Thiessen of Lowe Farm as member of the Governing Board of the Altona Hospital District #24 for the Term Jan.1, 1957 to Dec. 31, 1959. Carried.
