

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

APRIL 12, 1957.

The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. The meeting was opened by the Reeve after which the minutes of the March 8th Council session were read and adopted by motion of Wm. Recksiedler and Otto Bunkowsky.

- By-Law #843 Passed. Otto Bunkowsky-Wm. Recksiedler: That By-Law #843 being a By-Law for the purpose of controlling grasshopper infestation having been read a first time, be now considered as having been read a second and third time and passed. Carried.
- Old Age Pension Applications approved. Wm. Recksiedler-B. W. Thiessen: That the Old Age Pension applications of Mrs. Gertruda Martens of Lowe Farm and of Bernhard Heinrichs of Morris, Manitoba be approved. Carried.
- T.Macdonald appointed arbitrator St.Martin to Youville M. Ribordy-Ed. Saurette: That we appoint Ted Macdonald of Aubigny as arbitrator re the petition of E. Bellemare et al requesting the transfer of the South Half of Sec. 29-4-2East from the St. Martin S.D. #1075 and adding same to the Youville S.D.#942. Carried.
- By-Law #842 Passed. B. W. Thiessen-Wm. Schellenberg: That By-Law No. 842, being a By-Law for the purpose of taking a vote on the Money By-Law of The Consolidated School District of Kane No. 2006 (By-Law No. 1-57), having been read a first time, be now considered as having been read a second and third time and passed and the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer are hereby authorized to sign and seal same. Carried.
- Contribution and members Re Flood Control Committee. Wm. Recksiedler-M. Ribordy: That we appoint C. J. Neufeld and Otto Bunkowsky as members to the committee which will study Flood Control measures in the Red River Basin and, as a committee, report its recommendations to the Royal Commission on Flood Cost-Benefit. Furthermore, that we contribute \$50.00 towards expenses of this committee. Carried.
- Museum Grant B. W. Thiessen-Otto Bunkowsky: That we grant the Agricultural Memorial Museum of Manitoba, Austin, the sum of \$25.00 towards expansion of said museum. Carried.
- Agricultural Grant. Ed. Saurette-Wm. Schellenberg: That we grant the Morris Agricultural Society the sum of \$200.00 for the year 1957. Carried.
- Accounts. M. Ribordy-B. W. Thiessen: That the accounts as passed by the Finance Committee for \$34,807.05 be approved and the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer are hereby authorized to pay same. Carried.
