| Abandon Drains.                                    | Wm. F. Recksiedler-Wm. Schellenberg: That we request the Drainage Maintenance Board to abandon that portion of the St. Peters Drain on Sec. 34-4-1W South of the Shannon Creek; and that portion of Drain 28 situate on Sec. 34-4-1WPM.  | Carried. |
| Street Lights for Lowe Farm.                       | B. W. Thiessen-M. Ribordy: That we request the Manitoba Power Commission to install 6 street lights, 100 Watts each on Reimer Street and three 100 Watt street lights on Centre Street in the Village of Lowe Farm.  | Carried. |
