The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. The meeting was opened by the Reeve after which the minutes of the September 13th Council session were read and adopted by motion of Ed. Saurette and B. W. Thiessen.

Arbitrator appointed re Sperling S. D. #1488 Petition

Otto Bunkowsky-B. W. Thiessen: That we appoint M. J. Stevenson of Silver Plains as arbitrator re the petition of J. B. Hooper et al requesting the transfer of the following lands to the Sperling School District No. 1488:

- N $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec's 7, 8, & 9 in Twp 6, Rge 1 WPM
- N $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec's 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 & 12 in Twp. 6, Rge 2 WPM
- N $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec's 11 and 12, Twp 6, Rge 3 WPM
- W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec's 14, 23, 26 & 35, Twp 6, Rge 3 WPM
- W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec's 11, 14 & 23 in Twp.7, Rge 3 WPM

(The North West of Sec's 9 and 10 in Twp 6 Rge 2 WPM are in the Sperling Consolidated S. D.)

3 year lease re Gravel Pit

Wm. F. Recksiedler-Otto Bunkowsky: That we enter into an agreement with Ulric St. Godard of St. Jean to lease: Part of SE 33-4-2 EPM for three years for the purpose of a gravel pit and pay him at the price of 25¢ a yard for gravel removed.
