The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. The meeting was opened by the Reeve, after which the minutes of the November 8th meeting were read and adopted by motion of W. F. Recksiedler and W. F. Schellenberg.

Old Age Pension	W.F.Schellenberg-M.Ribordy: That the Old Age pension application of Isaac D. Harms, RRL, Morris, Be approved. Carried
Old Age Pension	W.F.Schellenberg-B.W.Thiessen: That the Old Age pension application of Mrs Mary (A.R.) Klassen, RRL, Morris be approved.
Piling order-1958	O. Bunkowsky-Ed. Saurette: That we order 300 lengths of piling from Archie Delorme, Aubigny, with the following specifications: 150 of 20' lengths with not less than 8" tops; 150 of 15' lengths with not less than 8" tops, at a price of 33 cents a foot, delivered to Morris. Carried
Stock Watering Dams	W.F.Schellenberg-O.Bunkowsky: That we request P.F.R.A. to survey and construct Stock Watering dams on the Morris River. Carried
Petition re St.Marys Rd gravel Aubigny to R.M.Ritchot	E.Saurette-B.W.Thiessen: Whereas 43 electors of Ward Four in The Rural Municipality of Morris have petitioned the Council to request the Dept of Public Works to gravel St. Mary's Road in 1958, from the Village of Aubigny North to the boundary of Ritchot Municipality, Now therefore the Council in session assembled requests the Dept of Public Works to consider this request, as per petition attached. Carried
Taxes and Hosp. Accts Cancelled	O. Bunkowsky-Ed.Saurette: That By-Law No. 848 being for the purpose of cancelling certain taxes and hospital accounts, having been read a first time, be now considered as having been read a second and third time and passed and the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer are hereby authorizee to sign and seal same. Carried
Closing & Opening Road at River Lots 491 & 493 and 495 & 497	O. Bunkowsky-E.Saurette: That By-Law No. 847a being a By-Law for the purpose of closing Public Road Road between River Lots 495 & 497 and open a Public Road between River Lots 491 & 493 having been read a first time, be now considered as having been read a second & third time and passed and the Reeve and Sec.-Treasurer are hereby authorizee to sign and seal same. Carried
Honorarium Drain.Trustee	O. Bunkowsky-B.W.Thiessen: That we pay C.J.Neufeld the sum of \$200.00 in recognition of services rendered as Drainage Trustee for the year 1957. Carried
Accounts	M. Ribordy-B.W.Thiessen: That the accounts as passed by the Finance Committee for \$18,778.40 be approved, and the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer are authorized to pay same. Carried
Pay staff for extra services	O. Bunkowsky-E.Saurette: That we pay D.J.Harder \$200.00 for extra services rendered in regards to Gravel Pit and Alice Loving \$150. for extra services in typing the 1958 Tax Roll. Carried
