The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. The minutes of the January 10th session were read and adopted by motion of B.W.Thiessen and O. Bunkowsky.

Boundary road at Kane
B.W.Thiessen-M.Ribordy: Whereas a delegation of ratepayers from the R. M. of Morris and the R. M. of Roland have requested the reconstruction and ~~xxxx~~ gravelling of the Boundary Road South of Kane,
Now therefore, we agree to reconstruct and gravel this road, being West of sections 6, 7, 18, 19, 30 and 31 in Township 4, Range 2 WP.M., providing the Municipality of Roland is agreeable to share in the cost of same on a 50/50 basis.

M. Ribordy-O.Bunkowsky: That we appoint A.K.Brown of Sperling, as arbitrator re the petition of Robert Karlowsky et al, requesting the transfer of Section 11, Section 2 and the East Half of Section 3, all in Township 8, Range 2 West, from the School District of Upland #1605 and adding same to the Consolidated School District of Brunkild #1281.

Ed. Saurette-B.W.Thiessen: That we appoint Ted Macdonald of Aubigny as arbitrator re the petition of M. Lemoine et al, requesting the transfer of the following lands and adding same to the Ste. Agathe School District #974:-
1. From St. Adolphe S.D., the most W'ly 21.8 acres of River Lot 586 and the most W'ly 9 3/4 acres of River Lot 588.
2. From Union Point School District #53, River Lot #537.
3. From Cartier S.D. #100, River Lots No's: 605, 607, 609, 611, 613, 615, 617, 619, 621, 623, 625 and 627.

W.F.Schellenberg-O.Bunkowsky: That this Municipality request an investigation of the Morris River for stock watering dams from Section 13-6-1 W along the water course South and East to the outlet into the Red River.
That this Municipality request and approve the construction by P.F.R.A. of Stock Watering dams along this stretch of the Morris River.
That this Municipality agrees to maintain these dams after the expiration of one year from the date of completion.

delivered F.O.B. Morris, with shipment to be completed by March 31st.

That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$5,115.11 be passed for payment. Carried

Delegations
A delegation headed by P.H.Penner, Kane, requested the gravelling of the 6 mile road due South of Kane.
A delegation consisting of Messrs Legal, Peloquin, Wallace & Levesque from the R.M. of Ritchot requested financial assistance in the construction of a bridge across the Red River at St. Agathe. It was felt that if any assistance would be made, the area of the R.M. of Morris bordering close to St. Agathe would have to be formed into a Local Improvement District and a vote taken by the ratepayers for this purpose.

A Special Meeting will be held at 10 a.m. on MONDAY, February 24th for the purpose of setting the estimates of monies required for the operation of the municipality for 1958; and the next regular meeting will be held at 10 a.m., March 14, 1958.
