SPECIAL MEETING

February 24, 1958

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held a special meeting on the above date with all members present. The purpose of the meeting was to set the estimates of expenditures required by the municipality for the year 1958 and to arrange for the hiring of employees for this year.

The requirements of expenditures of the corporation were discussed in part but not definite amounts were set. Further discussion of the Budget was left for the next regular meeting.

The employee question was discussed at length and it was decided to operate equipment with a one man shift for tractors and a two men daily shift for the Northwest Dragline. The wage rate was increased by 5 and 10¢ per hour in most cases. Time clocks were to be used on most of the machines and a rental rate set for machines, which rate would be charged to Wards according to time worked.
