

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

OCTOBER 10, 1958.

The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. The meeting was opened by the Reeve after which the minutes of the September 12th regular meeting and the minutes of the September 16th and September 30th Special meetings be were read and adopted by motion of Ed. Saurette and Wm. Recksiedler.

Request for D.M.D. changes.

Wm. Recksiedler-Wm. Schellenberg: That we request the Drainage Maintenance Board to make the following changes in the Drainage Maintenance District of the Rural Municipality of Morris:  
1. Construct a drain North of Sections 35 and 36 in Township 5, Range 1 WPM and North of Sec. 31-5-1E and include same in D.M.D. "V4".  
2. Reroute the Klassen Drain from the NW of 30-5-1 EPM along the road allowance of said section to the Morris River.  
3. Extend the Bell Drain, North of Sec. 9-5-1EPM along the road allowance to the Morris River.

Carried.

Model D. Maintainer rate.

B. W. Thiessen-Ed. Saurette: That the hourly rate for the New Model D. Maintainers for Non-Ward work be set at \$4.50 per hour

Carried.

Survey Request.

Wm. Schellenberg-Otto Bunkowsky: That we request the Drainage Maintenance Board to survey that portion of River Lots 493 through to River Lots 511 for the purpose of constructing a drain from the Union Point Drain to the Red River.

Carried.

Accounts.

Otto Bunkowsky-Wm. Schellenberg: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$26,007.24 be passed for payment.

Carried.

COURT OF REVISION

M. Ribordy-B. W. Thiessen: Resolved that the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris assemble as a Court of Revision to hear complaints on the 1959 assessments.

Carried.

Six written appeals and those of the assessor were presented to the Court.

Assessors' Appeals Adopted.

Otto Bunkowsky-Ed. Saurette: That we adopt the appeals of the Assessor covering changes in assessment value, change in ownership, change in acreage and deletions from roll as listed in Form "B"

M. Ribordy-B. W. Thiessen: That the Court of Revision having heard all written complaints and made its decisions, be now adjourned.
