Wm. Recksiedler-Wm. F. Schellenberg:

1. That the Province be requested to act as agents of the Municipality for the reconstruction of the Kronsgart Drain Outlet through sections 8 and 9-4-1E.
2. That the Province be requested to assume 1/3 the cost of the work including right-of-way.
3. That upon completion of the work the drain be taken over for maintenance by the Board of Trustees for Drainage Maintenance District "G".

- WARD 1: Poll #1: All duly qualified electors of the Ward, with the exception of Sections 2, 3 & 4 in Township 4, Range 1W, vote at BROADVIEW SCHOOL.
- WARD 2: Poll #1: All duly qualified electors of the Ward residing West of the Meridian vote at the NORTH FLOWERY BANK SCHOOL.
and
Poll #2: All duly qualified electors of the Ward residing East of the Meridian vote at the NORTH ROSENHOFF SCHOOL.
- WARD 3: Poll #1: All duly qualified electors of the Ward residing West of the C.P.R. vote at the GREENBANK SCHOOL
and
Poll #2: All duly qualified electors of the Ward residing East of the C.P.R. vote at PELLAND'S STORE, Silver Plains.
- WARD 4: Poll #1: All duly qualified electors of the Ward residing South of the division line between Townships 5 and 6 (South of R.L. 418 and Sections 35 & 36-6-2E) vote at the ARMOUR SCHOOL;
and
Poll #2: All duly qualified electors of the Ward residing North of the division line between Townships 5 and 6 (North of R.L. 416 and Sections 25 & 26-5-2E) vote at the NORMANDIN HALL, Aubigny.
