NOMINATION DAY - OCTOBER 13, 1959

A meeting of the electors was held on the above date at 2 p.m. at which nominations for Reeve and Councillors for Wards Three, Five and Six were received.

Six ratepayers from Ward Five attended.

As only the required number of candidates were nominated in Wards Three and Six, as well as for Reeve, the Returning officer declared Otto Bunkowsky, Maurice Ribordy and Bruce MacKenzie elected by acclamation.

Two Nominations were received for Ward Five, namely:

B. W. Thiessen and C. J. Neufeld

an election was declared to be held on October 23.

The minutes of October 14th, 1958, Nomination Meeting were read and adopted by motion of J.H.Friesen and J.J.Friesen.

Reeve Bruce MacKenzie was asked to chair the meeting and called upon the Councillors to report on the activities and expenditures in each Ward.

The Reeve followed these reports by explaining the various appropriations of the 1959 Budget and expenditures made to date. He also reported on drainage works. Due to unfavorable weather conditions this year many drains and roads have not been completed.

A discussion period followed, touching on subjects like: Weeds, Van Routes, purchasing mowers for weed cutting, etc.

The candidates for Ward Five acknowledged their nominations.
