That we request the Dept. of Public Works for a grant of 60% of the cost of gravelling the following project:

1. Gravelling Inter-Municipal boundary road between the Rural Municipality of "orris and DeSalaberry from NE 36-5-2E to NE 1-6-2E, 1 mile, with 300 yards of gravell at an estimated cost of \$600.00 ated cost of \$600.00.

(This mile being an approved Bus Route by the Red River School Division).

W.F.Recksiedler-W.F.Schellenberg:

WHEREAS the reconstruction and gravelling of PTH #23 has not been completed, and existing weather conditions made this road impassable, resulting in detouring traffic to our market roads, namely:

Lowe Farm - Rosenfeld Road and Sewell Road to PTH #75;

And Whereas this detouring of traffic has caused severe damage to these roads, requiring constant maintenance as well as more gravel to keep same passable;

Now therefore, the Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris requests the Dept. of Public Works for a Special Grant to re-gravel said 16 miles with about 250 yards per mile @ \$2.75 per yard or an estimated cost of \$11,000.00

W.F.Schellenberg-W.F.Recksiedler:

Due to weather conditions halting harvest work at an early date, be it resolved that tax payments be accepted without penalty, providing said taxes are paid by NOVEMBER 30, 1959.
