B. W. Thiessen-Wm. F. Schellenberg: Whereas P.T.H. #23 is to be black topped in 1960, from Morris West;
And Whereas soil conditions in this area are similar to those existing in the area ~~are similar to those existing in the area~~ from PTH #75 to Rosenfeld on PTH #14, where it was deemed advisable to concrete said road;
Now Therefore, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris would strongly recommend to the Dept. of Public Works to surface in concrete that portion of PTH #23 from Morris to Kane, when this road is completed in 1960.
The previous Minister of Public Works Mr. "Robertson" was in accord with this recommendation when council met with him in the early part of 1958.
