 1. Gravel La Salle Road from Morris to Macdonald Municipality boundary, 11½ miles at 600 yards per mile, at an estimated cost of \$20,700.00  
 2. Gravel Lowe Farm to Brunkild Road, 10 miles at 300 yards per mile, at an estimated cost of \$11,700.00  
 3. Construct a 5 span bridge across Morris River, between 31-5-1 EPM and 6-6-1 EPM at an estimated cost of \$12,000.00

Grants

That we request the Dept of Public Works for a Grant of 60% of the cost of  
gravelling and re-grading the following portions of School Division Bus routes:

- 1 - East of Sec 8, S of 17 and E of 19,30 & 31, twp 4, Rge 2 W,  
5 miles @ 400 yards per mile - 2000 yards - Estimated cost \$2.75 yd- \$5,500.
- 2 - East of Sec. 7, S of 18 and W of 18 & 19-4-1W and W 24-4-2W,  
5 miles @ 400 yds per mile, - 2000 yds - Estimated cost \$2.75 yd - \$5,500.
- 3 - East of Sec 17, S of 20 and E of 19,30 & 31 -4-1E,  
5 miles @ 400 yds per mile - 2000 yds - Estimated cost \$2.50 yd - \$5,000.
- 4 - North of Sec 34, S of 27 & 28, E of 20, NW'ly 29, S of 30 in  
Twp 5, Rge 1 E and E of 7-6-1E. 7 miles @ 400 yds per mile or  
2800 yards at an estimated cost of \$2.50 per yard ..... \$7,000.
