The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. The minutes of the May 13th Council meeting were read and adopted by motion of B. W. Thiessen and Wm. F. Schellenberg.

Sec.-Treas. Short Course.

B. W. Thiessen-Ed. Saurette: That we authorize the closing of the office during the time the office staff is attending the course in Municipal Administration and that the registration, living and travelling expenses incurred during this time be paid by the municipality.

Grant-Man. Travel Assoc.

Otto Bunkowsky-Wm. Recksiedler: That we make a grant of \$25.00 to the Manitoba Travel and Convention Association.

Request for Culvert on Mile 28.2-Letellier Subdivision. Otto Bunkowsky-Ed. Saurette: That we request the Canadian National Railways to install a culvert on Mile 28.2 Letellier Subdivision to improve drainage conditions in vicinity of R.L.'s 463 and 465 as per your plan and profile File 1605-L-25. The Municipality agrees to deepen the ditch east of the track according to your profile. Carried.

Request for a survey in D.M.D. "X" Ed. Saurette-B. W. Thiessen: That we request the Drainage Maintenance Board to make a survey in D.M.D. "X" for the purpose of constructing a drainage ditch connecting excisting drains from R.L. 432 to R.L. 450. done under supervision of the Drainage Maintenance Board on a 1/3 share carried by the D. M. Board and 2/3 share by the Municipality.

Request Bridge across Morris River 31-5-1E

W.Schellenberg-O.Bunkowsky: That we request the Water Control and Conservation Branch to recommend what size **hri** and type of bridge would be required across the Morris River, between Sec. 31-5-1E and 6-6-1E, as well as prepare an estimate of cost on donstruction of such bridge. Said bridge is now impassable Carried and your early attention is requested.

Ward Gravel Appropriation

B. Thiessen-M. Ribordy: That the following gravel be appropriated to the respective Wards for 1960 and placed on approved Market Roads: Ward 3 - 2500 yards Ward 4 - 1300 " Ward 5 - 2400 yards Ward 1 - 600 yards Ward 2 - 2000 "

Ward 6 - 2200 "

A Total of 11,000 yards.

Carried

Gravelling other than Main Market Roads

O.Bunkowsky-W.Recksiedler: That the cost of gravelling roads, other than approved Market Roads, be shared on a 50/50 basis by the Ward and ratepayers affected, providing the Ward has sufficient funds to approve such gravelling. New miles to be gravelled at a minimum of 300 yards per mile; re-gravelling roads at a 100 yds minimum per mile, providing ratepayers agree to share 50% of the costs. Carried

Gravel Checkers E.Saurette-B.Thiessen: That the following gravel checkers be hired at \$1.30 per hour and 10¢ a mile travelling expense: J.J.Friesen, Lowe Farm & Tom Davidson, Morris. Carried

Ward price for gravel M.RIbordy-B.Thiessen: That the cost of gravel used in Wards be set at \$1.00 per yard for crushed gravel, plus cost of hauling.

Declared area under Man. Water Supply Board

E. Saurette-W.F.Schellenberg: That the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris requests the Minister of Agriculture & Conservation to recommend to the Lieutenand-Governor-in-Council that The R.M. of Morris be declared an area towwhich the Manitoba Water Supply Board is authorized to supply water, in accordance with Section 10 of "The Manitoba Water Supply Board Act". Carried

M. Ribordy-W.F.Scheellenberg: Whereas the 1960 List of Electors has been duly advertised for thirty days, and no written complaint received, be it now resolved that said List be adopted and the Court of Revision re same be adjourned. Carried
