MAY 12, 1961.

The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. The minutes of the April 14th Council meeting were read and adopted by motion of Otto Bunkowsky and B. W. Thiessen.

- Carried.
- School Arbitrator Appointed. Maurice Ribordy-Ed. Saurette: That we appoint Zeph Odette, Otterburne as arbitrator re the petition of Rene Robert and others requesting the transfer of the following lands from the Provencher S.D. #997 and adding same to Consolidated S.D. of St. Agathe #2385: Part R.L. 473 and all River Lots 475, 477, 479, 481, 483, also the NW portion of Sec. 17-6-2 East.
- Carried.
- Gravel Agreement-20¢ per yard. Wm. F. Schellenberg-Wm. F. Recksiedler: That we enter into an agreement with U. St. Godard of St. Jean to remove gravel from the Pit situated on SE 33-4-2E for the next 3 years at 20¢ per yard removed.
- Carried.
- Bus Route Approved-Request for Grant re gravelling, regrading route. Otto Bunkowsky-Wm. F. Schellenberg: That we approve of the School Division BUS ROUTE from Pleasant Valley School, North of NE 34, North of 35 and 36 in Township 5, Range 1 WPM to the Principle Meridian, as certified qualified as a bus route by the Morris-Macdonald School Division Board. Furthermore, that we request the Dept. of Public Works for a grant of 60% of the cost of gravelling and regrading said route when required.

- Roland Medical Nursing Unit. Maurice Ribordy-B. W. Thiessen: That we authorize the Governing Board of the Carman Memorial Hospital District to dispose of the Roland Medical Nursing Unit and apply the monies from sale of same to the outstanding debenture debt.
- Carried.
- Rates Re. Tree Planter. Otto Bunkowsky-Wm. F. Recksiedler: That the rate for use of the Tree Planter with Tractor and man be set at \$3.50 per hour or part thereof when planting in the Municipality and \$5.00 per hour plus travelling expense, when Planter is used outside the Municipality. Rental of Planter only at \$10.00 a day, from time machine leaves Morris until it is returned.

- Bridge Timber Sale. Maurice Ribordy-B. W. Thiessen: That the Sale of Old Bridge Timber be held on Saturday, June 17th at the Municipal Shed, Morris at 2 P.M.
- Carried.
- Gravel Contract Re. Hauling and Crushing. B. W. Thiessen-Wm. F. Schellenberg: That we contract with John Dueck, R.R.1, Morris to haul and crush gravel for our 1961 Market Road program at the following price: Hauling at 7½¢ per yard per mile hauled and Crushing at 55¢ a yard loaded on trucks.

- Maintenance Re. Kronsgart Drain. Wm. F. Recksiedler-B. W. Thiessen: That we request the Drainage Maintenance Board to include the "Kronsgart Drain" under a 2/3 government share and 1/3 Municipal share for maintenance of said drain, for reasons that this drain carries a large quantity of foreign waters.

- School Arbitrator Appointed. Wm. F. Recksiedler-Wm. F. Schellenberg: That we appoint Dan Recksiedler of Sewell as arbitrator re the petition of Mrs. J. B. Giesbrecht and others requesting the transfer of SE 20-4-1W from Steinfeld S.D. to the Consolidated S.D. of Lowe Farm #2377.

- School Arbitrator Appointed. Otto Bunkowsky-Ed. Saurette: That we appoint Dan Recksiedler of Sewell as arbitrator re the petition of P. Peters and others requesting the transfer of S½ of 30-4-1W from the Kronswende S.D. To the Lowe Farm Consolidated S.D. #2377.

- School Arbitrator Appointed. Maurice Ribordy-B. W. Thiessen: That we appoint Dan Recksiedler of Sewell as arbitrator re the petition of D. H. Froese and others requesting the transfer of NE 19-4-1W from Kronswende S.D. to the Lowe Farm Consolidated S.D. #2377.

Ed. Saurette-Otto Bunkowsky: That we request the Drainage Maintenance Board to survey North of Section 10 and 11-5-2E, D.M.D. "X" for a drain and if feasible to construct, this work to be completed on a Municipal Aid Basis.

Wm. F. Recksiedler-Maurice Ribordy: That we make application to the Manitoba Telephone System to install a Telephone in the Municipal Equipment Shed.

Request Re Grant of gravelling School Division Bus Routes.

Wm. F. Schellenberg-B. W. Thiessen: That we request the Dept. of Public Works for a Grant of 60% of the cost of gravelling the following School Division Bus Routes:

- 1. East of Sec. 8, S. of 17 and E of 19, 30 & 31-4-2W;  
6.5 Miles @ 250 Yards (1250 Yards) Est. cost <sup>18,</sup> ~~4330~~ <sup>31</sup> \$3,750.00
- 2. East 7, S of 18 and W Of 18 & 19-4-1W and W 24-4-2W;  
7.5 Miles @ 250 Yards (1250 Yards) Est. cost \$3,750.00
- 3. East of Sec. 17, S of 20 and E. of 19, 30, and 31-4-1E;  
5 Miles @ 250 Yards (1250 Yards) Est. cost \$3,750.00
- 4. North of Sect's 34, S of 27 & 28, E of 20, NW<sup>ly</sup> 29,  
S of 30 in 5-1E and E of 7-6-1E;  
7 Miles @ 250 Yards (1750 Yards) Est. cost \$5,250.00

Request for Grant-regravelling Sperling-Aubigny Road.

Otto Bunkowsky-Ed. Saurette: That we request the Dept. of Public Works for a Special Grant of 60% for regravelling the Sperling-Aubigny Road at 200 Yards per mile at an estimated cost of \$15,600.

N of Sections 20 to 24-6-2W and N of 19 to 23 and West of 24, 13 and 12 and S. of 12-6-1W and S of 7 to 12 in 6-1E and S 7-6-2E through R.L.'s 449 & 450 and South of 11 & 12-6-2E
