Wm. F. Schellenberg-Ed. Saurette: Resolution of The Rural Municipality of Morris consenting to the use of the following described lands for cemetery purposes: PARCEL 1: The most Easterly one and one-half chains in width of the most Northerly two and one quarter chains in depth of the South half of Section Twenty (20) in Township Five (5) and Range One (1) East of the Principal Meridian in Manitoba.

PARCEL 2: Being the most Northerly Two Hundred (200) feet in perpendicular width of all that portion of the North-west quarter of Section Twenty-nine in the Fifth Township and First Range East of the Principal Meridian in Manitoba, which lies between two straight lines drawn Southerly at right angles to the Northern limit of said quarter section from points in the same distant Easterly thereon Eight Hundred and sixty-one and five-tenths (861.5) feet and Twelve hundred and ninety-four (1294.0) feet respectively from the North-west angle of said quarter section.

BE IT RESOLVED and it is hereby resolved that the Rural Municipality of Morris, in Manitoba hereby consents to the use of the above described lands for cemetery purposes.
