Recksiedler: That By-Law No. 886, being a By-Law for the purpose of rescinding By-Law No's 875, 823, 822, 851, 874, 831, 853 and 833 covering Street Lighting contracts for the Municipality; And Approving draft contracts between Manitoba Hydro and the Municipality (Schedules A,B,C,D,E,F,G and H.), having been read a first time, be now considered as having been read a second and third time and passed.
