Tax and Hospital  
Cancellation  
By-Law Passed.

B. W. Thiessen-M. Ribordy: That By-Law No. 887 being a By-Law for the purpose of cancelling certain taxes and hospital accounts, having been read a first time, be now considered as having been read a second and third time and passed.

Market Road-  
31-5-2W

M. Ribordy-Otto Bunkowsky: That we approve of the request of petitioners signed by R. S. Swain et al asking that the road running South of Sec.'s 35 & 36 in 5-3-1W and North of Section 31-5-2W be designated a Market Road under the Main Market Road System as now established by the Province of Manitoba and the Municipalities concerned.

Reconstruct  
Cobb Drain  
North 28-4-2W

B. W. Thiessen-Wm. F. Recksiedler: That we request the Water Control & Conservation Branch to take proceedings to complete the following project:

1. That the Cobb Drain be cleaned out North of Sec. 28-4-2W and that the drain East of SE 35-4-2W be also cleaned out in order to provide adequate drainage to an outlet through the South dyke of the Shamon Creek Floodway East of 35-4-2W. This work to be carried out under the Drainage Maintenance District program.

The following work to be done under Capital Construction with the Province assuming 100% of the cost:

2. That the bridge located East of 34-4-2W be removed and the hole under the existing bridge be filled up to the general coulee level and an 18" C.M.P. be placed under an earthfill after the existing bridge is removed.
3. That water be conveyed Southerly from the ridge immediately North of the existing bridge to the Cobb Drain.
4. That water North of the above described ridge be conveyed Northerly to the South outside drain of the South Shannon Creek Dyke.
