Otto Bunkowsky-Ed. Saurette: That we make a retro-active pay of 10¢ an hour work Snowplow and bonus from January 1st to March 31st, 1962 to Snowplow and Cat. Operators cat Operators caecording to their pay records.

M. Ribordy-Wm. F. Recksiedler: Pursuant to the "Brief" recently submitted, requesting the Construction of a dam near the mouth of the Morris River to establish a reservoir sufficient to serve the needs of the communities in our Municipality; Now therefore be it resolved:

That we request the Minister of Agriculture for the approval of construction of Dam "C" crest elevation 755; as proposed in the preliminary report by the P.F.R.A. dated July 1961, at or near the mouth of the Morris River.
