Upon completion of construction work the Drain be taken over for maintenance by the Board of Drainage Maintenance Trustees under DMD $^{n}X^{n}$. That the Rural Municipality of Morris assume the responsibility of getting permission from said land owners for the above construction work.

Carried.

Request for reconstruction of the Rehill Drain Outlet. Otto Bunkowsky-Wm. F. Schellenberg; That the Province be requested, as agent, to reconstruct the "Rehill Drain Outlet" through South half of Sec. 34-6-1 WPM. That the Province be requested to pay one-third of the cost of construction. That the Rural Municipality of Morris agrees to pay the remaining one-third of the cost of construction.

Upon completion of construction work the Drain be taken over for maintenance by the Board of Drainage Maintenance Trustees under DMD "V3"

That the Rural Municipality of Morris assume the responsibility of getting permission from said land owner or owners for the above construction work.

Street Light Request for Sperling. Maurice Ribordy-Otto Bunkowsky: That we request the Manitoba Hydro Commission to install one 150 Watt Street Light on East end of Henry Street in the Village of Sperling.

Street Light Request for Aubigny. Ed. Saurette-Wm. F. Schellenberg: That we request the Manitoba Hydro Commission to install one 150 Watt Street Light North of Lot 3, Plan 3649 in the Village of Aubighy on Ferry Road.

Carried.

Altona Hosp. Board member appointed. Ed. Saurette-Wm. F. Schellenberg: That we appoint the Councillor for Ward 5 as our member to the Governing Board of the ALTONA HOSPITAL DISTRICT No. 24 for the balance of the late "B. W. Thiessen's" term, namely to December 31st, 1962.

By-Law No. 894 read a third time and passed.

Otto Bunkowsky-Wm. F. Recksiedler: That By-Law No. 894, being a By-Law for the purpose of ratifying and confirming the establishment of further hospital facilities for the Altona Hospital District No. 24, having received the assent of the retepayers on August 24th, be now read a third time and passed.

Otto Bunkowsky-Wm. F. Schellenberg: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$27,601.05 be passed for payment. Carried.

Anti-Freeze Tender Accepted. Otto Bunkowsky-Wm. F. Recksiedler: That we accept the Anti-Freeze Tender of J. R. Friesen & Sons to supply the municipality with 90 Gallons of Glycol base Anti-Freeze at \$2.25 per gallon.

Appeals of Assessor Adopted. COURT OF REVISION

Court of Revision Adjourned. The Court of Revision opened at 3 P.M. with 6 written appeals received.
