The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular meeting on the above date with all members present. The minutes of the April 11th Council Meeting were read and adopted by motion of Otto Bunkowsky and M. Ribordy.

- Request Re C. J. Neufeld-Wm. F. Schellenberg: Revised Resolution: That we request the Department of Public Works for a Special Grant in the following villages:
- Special AUBIGNY: Gravelling Main Street and flankage from River Lot 446 to River Lot 450, passed Provencher School and the St. Antoine Catholic Church.
- Grant for 300 yards of gravel, Estimated Cost.....\$ 900.00
- Street ROSENORT: Gravelling Main Street North and flankage passed the Shopping Centre of the Village
- Gravel. 750 yards of gravel, Estimated Cost.....\$2,250.00
- SPERLING: Gravelling Main Street and flankage from Waddell Street South to P.T.H. #3, passed the Sperling United Church and Sperling School.
- 800 yards of gravel, Estimated Cost.....\$2,400.00
- LOWE FARM: Gravelling road from P.T.H. #23 passed the Morris-Macdonald School Division Collegiate; to First Avenue; westerly on First Ave. to Fifth Street, passing the Berghaler Church, Emmanuel Church and the Lowe Farm Curling Club, thence South to P.T.H. #23.
- 800 yards of gravel, Estimated Cost.....\$2,400.00

- establishing Departments to have this matter approved as soon as possible.
