




JUNE 14, 1963.

- MAY 31, 1963.
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| By-Law #905 Re: sale of lots to David Penner passed. | C. J. Neufeld-Otto Bunkowsky: That By-Law No. 905, being a By-Law for the purpose of selling Lots 29 and 30 shown on a Plan of Survey of the Village of Lowe Farm and registered in the Morden Land Titles Office, for the price of \$100.00 plus \$25.00 for Legal Fees to David Penner of Village of Lowe Farm, having been read a first time, be now considered as having been read a second and third time and passed.

| School Arbitrator Appointed. | M. Ribordy-Wm. Recksiedler: That we appoint Dan Recksiedler of Sewell as arbitrator re the Petition of D. R. Johnson and others requesting the consolidation of the Molloy S.D. #1849 and the Morris S.D. #29. | Carried. |
| Gravel Checkers to be hired. | Otto Bunkowsky-Wm. F. Schellenberg: That we hire a gravel checker to check gravel placed on roads, at \$1.30 an hour and 10¢ a mile for travelling expenses; and one checker for the Gravel Pit at \$1.30 an hour and \$2.00 a day travelling expense. | Carried. |
| Sec.-Treas. Short Course. | Ed. Saurette-Wm. F. Recksiedler: That we authorize closing of the Office from June 17th to June 21st inclusive, while the Office Staff is attending the Course in Municipal Administration, and that the registration fee, living and travelling expenses during this time be paid by the Municipality. | Carried. |
| Request for re-design of drain. | C. J. Neufeld-Wm. F. Recksiedler: That we request the Drainage Maintenance Board to have the Dept. of Public Works re-design the drain on P.T.H. #23 South of Sec. 1 and 2, Twp.5, Rge. 2 WPM to carry waters North on the half mile on Section 1-5-2W to the "Anderson Drain", and abandon Drain on Sec.1 & 2 in 5-2 WPM; AND Take levels between Sections 33 and 34 in 4-2 WPM to ascertain whether a drain would be feasible to carry waters direct to the "Shannon Floodway" | Carried. |
| Request Re Enlarge-ment of D.M.D. "X" | Ed. Saurette-Wm. F. Schellenberg: That we request the Drainage Maintenance Board to include Sections 1, NE of 2, E $\frac{1}{2}$ of 11, All Sec. 12 & 13, E $\frac{1}{2}$ 14, E $\frac{1}{2}$ 23, All Sec. 24, SE 26, and All of 25 and 36 in Twp. 5, Rge 2 EPM. AND All of Sections 1 and 12 in Twp. 6, Rge. 2 EPM into Drainage Maintenance District "X" | Carried. |
| Change Re Street Lighting in Lowe Farm. | C. J. Neufeld-M. Ribordy: Resolved that the Council hereby authorize Manitoba Hydro to make the following changes to the street lighting system in the Village of Lowe Farm. It is agreed that this Resolution will constitute an amendment to the street lighting contract now in force, deleting four 100 Watt and two 300 Watt Street Lights and installing eight 175 Watt M.V. Street Lights. | Carried. |
| Accounts. | C. J. Neufeld-M. Ribordy: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$48,525.24 be passed for payment. | Carried. |
