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SPECIAL MEETING

October 23, 1963

The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris met in special session on the above date to discuss the Grant-in-Aid program for 1964, as well as a few other matters pertaining to the general welfare of the municipality. All members were present.

W. F. Schellenberg-C.J. Neufeld:

That we request the Dept. of Public Works for a Special Grant of 60% on the following proposed projects for the year 1964:

1. School Division Bus Routes re-gravelling as per map attached.
33 miles at an estimated cost of \$24,750.00
2. Re-grade and Gravel:
LaSalle Road from PTH #75 one-half mile West to Section 10-5-1EPM, thence North 6 miles to East of Sec. 3-6-1 EPM;

Low Farm - Rosenfeld Road from PTH #23 East of Sec. 32-4-1 WPM Southerly 3 miles;

a total of 9½ miles of Standard Class B road at an estimated cost of \$47,500.00

The above request was made with the plan in mind of reconstructing the "Approved Market Road System" of the municipality over a period of from 8 to 10 years.

The matter of Dugout filling was discussed; Council felt that as a corporation it did not want to be involved in this project. Previous experience proved it to be a costly venture and only serving a few ratepayers. Apparently private pumping units were available and ratepayers were advised to hire same on their own arrangements.

It was announced that an Industrial Development meeting for this area was to be held at 8 p.m. on October 29th.
