

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

| Report Given on Elderly Citizens Home. | W. F. Recksiedler reported on the committee meeting regarding the proposed Elderly Citizens Home in Morris.
A Motel style set-up was being investigated; Committee will check on existing ones in Morden, Manitou, Miami and Portage la Prairie, and report its findings to a general meeting. These units would rent at about \$45 to \$47.00 a month.
The area would have to raise about 5% of the cost of such a Home, as well as obtain a site large enough for same and for future expansion. The recommendations were that the site should be reasonably close to Town. |
