The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date, with all members present. The minutes of Dec. 10th and of Dec. 17th, 1965, meetings were adopted by motion of C. Neufeld & G. Goossen.

W. F. Schellenberg-W.F.Recksiedler: That we recommend a permit be issued to Jacob E. Gerbrandt, Lowe Farm (aircraft); Dick Isaac, McTavish (snow vehicle) and Gib Elliot, McTavish (snow vehicle) for the use of snow vehicle or aircraft in hunting foxes in the Rural Municipality of Morris.

C.J. Neufeld-W.F.Recksiedler: That we tender for our 1966 requirements of Diesel Fuel, Oils and Greases, to be delivered to our equipment. Lowest price not necessarily accepted. Tenders to be in hands of the Secretary by Feb. 10th.

W.F.Schellenberg-G.Goossen: That we appoint C.J.Neufeld, as our member to the Morris-Montcalm Weed Control District to complete the 1966 term, vacated by W.F.Schellenberg.

C.J.Neufeld-Ed. Saurette: That we request the Department of Public Works to install, as a safety measure for Pedestrians and Motor Vehicles, suitable lighting on the following bridges:

1. The Bridge situate at "Aubigny" on Provincial Road No. 205; and
2. The Bridge situate on P.T.H. #23 across the Red River, East of Morris, Man.

G.P.Goossen-W.F.Recksiedler: That we appoint C.J.Neufeld as our member to the Board of Directors of the Altona Hospital District for the term January 1, 1966 to December 31st, 1968.

C.J.Neufeld-Ed. Saurette: That we sell to "Gagne Gravel", St. Pierre, the sand and strippings from the North portion of our Gravel Pit for the price of 40¢ per yard. Estimated yardage required - 50,000 yards.

W.Recksiedler-E.Saurette: That we accept the tender of Henry & Frank Blatz, Kane P.O. offering to purchase Two 12 foot Moldboards for \$72.00.
