C.J.Neufeld-G.Goossen:

That the following Grants be made to:

That By-Law No. 938, being a by-law for the purpose of opening and closing of certain portions of a road thru River Lots 351 to 367 inclusive and SE 10-5-1E, be given second reading.

G. Goossen-C.Neufeld:

That By-Law No. 939, being a by-law for the purpose of providing the granting of a franchise for the supplying of Natural Gas and permitting Plains-Western Gas (Manitoba) Ltd. to use the highways of the municipality so that the company may distribute and sell natural gas to the inhabitants of the municipality in the designated area shown in the agreement attached, be given first reading and submitted to the Public Utilities Board for approval.

G. Goossen-W.Recksiedler:

That the resolution dated January 14th, selling sand and strippings to "Gagne Gravel" at St. Pierre, be rescinded.

W.Schellenberg-C.Neufeld:

That we sell to Commonwealth Constfuction, 768 Tache Ave., St.Boniface, the sand and strippings from the North portion of our gravel pit, for the price of 27¢ a ton. (Estimated tonnage required - 50,000 tons).

C.J.Neufeld-W.F.Schellenberg:

That we accept the Diesel Fuel tender of Lowe Farm Consumers Co-op. offering to deliver our Diesel Fuel requirements for 1966 to our equipment at 15.7¢ per gal for No. 1 and 17.7¢ per gallon No. 2.

Canadian National Railways requested permission to retire the station building at Lowe Farm. Councils opinion was to leave same as is.

G. Goossen-W.F.Schellenberg:


That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$8,414.43 be passed for payment.
