Minutes adopted	The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date, with all members present. It was moved by C.J. Neufeld and seconded by G. Goossen that the minutes of March 11th and March 15th meetings be adopted as read.
Caretaker bonus	E. Saurette-C. Neufeld: That we pay Cornelius Harder \$100.00 for extra caretaking duties at the Court House (Flood Headquarters) during the 1966 Flood. Carried
Western Gypsum Assessment	G.P. Goossen-Ed. Saurette: That the personal property assessment for Western Gypsum Products at Silver Plains amounting to \$42,960.00 be added to the 1965 and 1966 Tax Rolls in accordance with Sec. 1051 of the Municipal Act. Carried
Changes in Ownership	C.J. Neufeld-W.F. Schellenberg: That the changes in ownership as submitted by the Provincial Assessor under date of April 12th be approved and the Secretary authorized to make such changes in the 1966 Tax Roll. Carried
Sperling Street Lights	M. Ribordy-C.J. Neufeld: That we request the Manitoba Hydro to move the existing street light situate opposite Lot 26, Block 9, Plan 916 to the existing pole South West of Lot 28, Block 9, Plan 916; and also install one 175 watt mercury vapor light on existing pole South of Lot 22, Block 9, Plan 916. Carried

Recksiedler: That the 1965 Electors Roll be adopted for the year 1966 as per Sec. 50(4) of the Municipal Act and the Court of Revision in respect of same be held on July 8th, from 1 to 2 p.m. in the Court House Building in Morris, and the Secretary is hereby authorized to amend the revised List as per Sec. 52(3) of the Municipal Act. Purchasing D7 Cat, Dozer and Scraper B.L. 941	C.J. Neufeld-W.F. Schellenberg: That By-Law No. 941, being a by-law for the purpose of purchasing the following equipment from Powell Equipment Co. Ltd.: D7E Caterpillar Tractor, Hydraulic Angle Dozer and 435 Scraper for the price of Sixty thousand, five hundred dollars (\$60,500.) having been read a first time, be now read a second and third time and passed. Carried
