

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

August 12, 1966

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members, excepting Reeve Bruce MacKenzie, present. Deputy Reeve C.J. Neufeld chaired the meeting.

W.F. Schellenberg-W. Recksiedler: That the minutes of July 8th council meeting be adopted as read. Carried

W.F. Schellenberg-W. Recksiedler: That all cheques of the Corporation drawn on its General & Savings accounts, be signed by the Reeve and Secretary-treasurer, and in the absence of the Reeve, by the Deputy Reeve. Carried

W. Recksiedler-E. Saurette: That we appoint Benjamin J. Heinrichs of Lowe farm as arbitrator re the petition of R. Bobrowski et al requesting the transfer of certain lands from the Flowery Bank S.D. #837 to the Consolidated School District of Morris #2421. Carried

G. Goossen-W. Schellenberg: That we appoint Benjamin J. Heinrichs of Lowe Farm as arbitrator re the petition of J.J. Peters et al requesting the transfer of certain lands from the Rosenhoff S.D. #61 and transferring same to the Morris Consolidated School District #2421. Carried

Ed. Saurette-G. Goossen: That we appoint Benjamin J. Heinrichs as Lowe Farm as arbitrator re the petition of J.J. Peters et al, requesting the transfer of all the lands of the Broadview S.D. #957 to the Consolidated S.D. of Morris #2421. Carried

Ed. Saurette-G. Goossen: That we install an extra 48 inch culvert between Sections 5 and 8-5-2EPM to alleviate drainage problems North and South of PTH #23. Cost of this project to be shared by the R.M. of Montcalm- 25% and the R. M. of Morris - 75%. Carried

G. Goossen-W. Recksiedler: That we request the Water Control & Conservation Branch to build a grade level crossing East of Sec. 36-4-2W across the "Shannon Floodway" for reasons that this is the main outlet South of Lowe Farm, as well as a School Division Bus Route. Carried

W.F. Schellenberg-E. Saurette: That we request the Water Control & Conservation Branch to survey the "Cobb Drain" (North) through sections 33 & 34-4-2 WPM for the purpose of drain clean-out. Carried

W.F. Schellenberg-G. Goossen: That we request the Water Control & Conservation Branch to survey the drain through Sections 1-6-2E and 6-6-3E in order that a suitable clean-out job can be affected at an early date. (By phone) Carried

W.F. Schellenberg-W. Recksiedler: Whereas the bridge situate East of Sec 5-5-1E across the "Moyer Coulee" is impassable, and whereas the road approaching same has been properly graded, Now Therefore we request the Water Control & Conservation Branch to reconstruct said bridge to handle the flow of the "Shannon Floodway" waters and construct a bridge to grade level.

And furthermore, whereas the outlet of the "Moyer Coulee" is in dire need of cleaning, said clean-out is requested to receive your departments prompt attention. Carried

W. Schellenberg-M. Ribordy: That we request the Water Control & Conservation Branch to survey the "Bell Drain" from South of Sections 17, 18, 15, 14-1W and North & South of Sec 13-5-1W and North & South of Sec's: 18, 17, & 16 -5-1 EPM for the purpose of cleaning said drain and permit proper run-off of spring and summer waters; early attention by your department is anticipated. Carried

Ed. Saurette-W. Recksiedler: That we agree to clean the $\frac{1}{2}$ mile drain through Sec. 6-6-3E in the R.M. of DeSalaberry; costs of this project to be shared on a 50/50 basis. Carried

M. Ribordy-E. Saurette: Whereas Prov. Road #332 is closed SE 31-5-2 WPM due to closing of bridge, thus diverting all traffic to our municipal road on South of Section 32-5-2W; we now request the Dept. of Highways to gravel said road to suitably carry the traffic it now has to carry. Carried

W.F. Recksiedler-W.F. Schellenberg: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$22,777.54 be passed for payment. Carried

A delegation of six ratepayers from Ward 2 attended to discuss the feasibility of dyking the Riverside area to protect from future flooding; it was suggested that an extension of the proposed dyke at Rosenort could tie in with this project. In lieu of dyking, build higher roads to permit speedy evacuation.

J. B. Harder & Wm. Funk, representing their district, were anxious to know what action was being taken re improvements on the "Moyer" & "Kronsgart" drains. Dragline to move in and clean most serious obstacles. Demand was again made to remove trees at "Mueller's farm", as they create a serious menace to drains.

Harry Anderson and others requested cleaning and deepening of the "Bell Drain" Survey will be requested and dragline move in to alleviate worst problems.

Charles Anderson asked council to endorse a previous request by Elmer Sommers to widen and deepen the "Anderson Drain". Council will endorse this request.


Rene Phillipot, Westeel Products and Bob Harris, Vulcan Machinery, attended.
