

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

Sept. 9, 1966

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present.

W.F.Schellenberg-C.J.Neufeld: That the minutes of August 12th meeting be adopted as read. Carried

G. Goossen & E.Saurette: That we authorize the office staff to subscribe to the "Certificate Course for Municipal Secretary-Treasurers" and that the municipality pay the actual out-of-pocket registration, tuition, living and travelling expenses incurred therewith. Carried

C. Neufeld-M.Ribordy: That we tender for the lowest price on permanent glycol-base Anti-Freeze, in one gallon containers; quantity required - 80 gallons. Tenders to be in hands of the Secretary by September 23, 1966. Carried

W.F.Recksiedler-G.P.Goossen: That By-Law No. 939, being a by-law for the purpose of providing the granting of a franchise for the supplying of Natural Gas by Plains Western Gas (Man.) Ltd, be read a second time and submitted to the Public Utility Board for approval. Carried

W.F.Schellenberg-M.Ribordy: That we appoint Dick Eidse, RR1 Morris, as arbitrator re the petition of N.A.Roberts and others requesting the transfer of certain lands from the Cons. S.D. of Sperling #1488 to the Cons. S.D. of Carman #176. Carried

C.J.Neufeld-E.Saurette: That the Court of Revision for the purpose of hearing complaints against Real Property, Personal Property and Business assessments, changes in ownership & acreage and deletions from the 1967 Assessment Roll, be set for Friday, October 14th at 2:00 p.m. Carried

G.Goossen-W.Schellenberg: That the increases in assessment as shown in "Exhibit A" of the Assessment Branch, dated August 22nd, be added to the current Tax Roll, as provided for in Sec. 1051 of the Municipal Act. Carried

C.J.Neufeld-M.Ribordy: That we make application for Assistance under Section 3 of the Prairie Farm Assistance Act for that portion of the Rural Municipality of Morris, as per list attached, where the average yield is estimated to be 8 bushels or less per acre, due to spring flooding and excessive rains. Carried

W.F.Schellenberg-G.Goossen: That ~~the~~ By-Law No. 942, being a by-law for the purpose of consolidating the School Districts of: Greenbank, Rosenhoff, Rosenort, McTavish, Clover Plains, Flowery Bank and Pleasant Valley, be read a second time and submitted to the Minister of Education for approval. Carried

W.F.Schellenberg-E.Saurette: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$68,380.22 be passed for payment. Carried

The official opening and ribbon cutting ceremonies regarding the "Aubigny Bridge" will be held on Saturday, Sept. 24th at 3 p.m.

A delegation of ratepayers from Rosenort petitioned to have the "Brandt Road" on Section 7-6-1E widened, raised and gravelled. Right-of-way will have to be purchased before this project will be started.

Representatives from the Water Control & Conservation Branch attended the meeting regarding the proposed dyke around Morris. The engineers plan to build the dyke North of the present road on R.L. 321 did not meet with the approval of council.

The meeting adjourned.
