The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present.

W. F. Schellenberg-C.J. Neufeld:

That the minutes of October 14th Council Meeting be adopted as read. Carried

C.J. Neufeld-W.F. Recksiedler:

That Tax Sale Certificate #59 covering the "W'ly 300' of W'ly 300' of River Lot 315" be redeemed for reasons that it was improperly sold; this property is a private cemetery. Carried

Ed. Saurette-W.F. Schellenberg:

That By-Law No. 944 being a by-law for the purpose of selling Tax Sale property on Lot 9, Plan 3649, formerly owned by Edmond Berthelette, to Doris Robert of Aubigny for \$150.00, be read a first, considered as having been read a second & third time and passed. Carried

A letter from the Minister of Health was read which informed council that "it is proposed during the current fiscal year to establish one additional health unit and laboratory and X-ray unit, which will include your municipality". A proposed scheme was also submitted. Due to a considerable change in council for 1967, it was felt that this matter should be left for the in-coming council to decide upon.

The secretary was instructed to write the Water Control and Conservation Branch whether the municipality could obtain the bridge material left after dismantling certain bridges along the Morris River.

No word had been received regarding our request for a grade level crossing East of Section 36-4-2W. Another request was to be made.



G.P. Goossen-E. Saurette:


That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$32,156.75 be passed for payment. Carried
