The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present.

C. J. Neufeld-E. Saurette: That the minutes of November council meeting be adopted as read. Carried

Water Control Branch

- The Water control & Conservation Branch informed Council
1. That our request for obtaining old bridge materials left from bridges being dismantled along the Morris River was denied. The Province will use same on its own Provincial Waterways.
 2. That our request for a grade level crossing East of section 36-4-2W was not consented to at this time; a re-appraisal of the situation could be made after the spring runoff. Council is of the opinion that a bridge at this location is vitally essential and a further request direct to the Minister is to be made.
 3. That the survey in connection with an alternate outlet for the "Boundary Drain" had been completed and same had been submitted to the Planning Division for recommendation.
 4. That the drain North of Sec 3-5-1W has been scheduled for a cleanout in the 1967 program. This will involve the congested area North of Sec 1-5-1W, West to the Angle Drain junction, with the idea of increasing its capacity to that of the upstream portion.

Survey 7-6-1E

Surveyors Wilson, Neal & Hayward forwarded plans of the "Brandt" Street in Sec. 7-6-1E-Rosenort. Registration of this plan will be made as soon as approval has been received.

Public Utilities access Road on PTH #75

The Department of Public Utilities reported that the applications of a Propane Distributor and one of a Farm Implement Dealership, for access driveways onto P.T.H. #75 south of Morris, were denied. It recommended that this area should be developed by way of a Commercial Subdivision with provision being made for a Frontage Road adjacent to PTH #75 with a minimum of direct access from said Frontage Road onto PTH #75. This matter to be discussed more fully by the Town and Rural Councils and the Public Utilities Board.

Single District Divisions Meeting

The Morris-Macdonald Planning Committee has arranged a Consultative Seminar to be held Monday, Dec. 12th at Sanford at 4:30 p.m. The purpose of the seminar is to provide as much information as is available concerning the referendum of March 1967 in regards to single district divisions.

Bridge Piling

Joe Delorme of Marchand offered piling for sale but the present council felt that these piles were not adequate for our purpose.

Aid

Ed. Saurette-W.Recksiedler: That we increase the aid to Bernice Peck and Constance Nicholson, Morris, from \$30.00 to \$40.00 a month, effective Dec. 1st and reverting back to \$30.00 a month on May 1/67.
