The feasibility of constructing a diversionary channel from the Morris River to the Red River channel was discussed. The engineers agreed that this diversion could be made but expressed grave doubts whether the benefits derived from such a diversion would warrant the cost.


Obvious obstacles that retard the flow of water in the Morris River, such as plugs, brush etc. would no doubt receive attention at an early date.
